Thank you for your interest in applying for a Pikes Peak Kiwanis scholarship. As Kiwanians, we look to pass along and encourage our core values in your educational, extra-curricular and community goals.

The recipients of Pikes Peak Kiwanis Scholarships are upstanding members of their community and are dedicated to leading Colorado communities into a better future. We will consider students who have proven academic records in good standing throughout their high school careers and who have been accepted and plan to attend a college or university in Colorado.

The student must maintain a semester and cumulative Grade Point Average of at least 3.0 to be considered for a renewal scholarship each year. Additional renewal requirements are listed in the application.

The amount and number of scholarships will be decided by the Pikes Peak Kiwanis Scholarship Committee no later than April 15th each year.

Applications for the Pikes Peak Kiwanis Scholarship will be made available to students in the month of February for each school year. Completed applications must be received by March 15 each year.

Each recipient must identify the college he/she will be attending and provide a complete and sealed transcript from their high school. Scholarship funds will be made payable to the business office of the college of choice.

If a recipient receives another scholarship that covers full tuition to their college of choice, he/she will decline the Pikes Peak Kiwanis Scholarship, so that it may be awarded to another worthy recipient.
